2018 UGL REGIONAL COMPETITION UPDATE



Northern Blades and NSC will be hosting the 2018 Upper Great Lakes Championships Oct 4 -8, 2017. Placing in the top four positions in this event is the first step for skaters to qualify for the US Nationals in January 2018. In conjunction with this event we will also be hosting the 2018 UGL Competition which is the non-qualifying track. Northern Blades will have skaters competing in both the qualifying and non-qualifying events.

The club had to submit a bid and be chosen by US Figure Skating to host these competitions. We have previously submitted bids for this event and were not chosen so we really want to do a great job with this event to show them they made the right choice!

We are expecting 750 - 800 competitors between the two events. Skaters will come from MN, WI, IA, ND, SD, IL and MO. That said, we will be needing all the help we can get to make the events a huge success and be able to host these and other prestigious USFS events in the future.

The initial schedule will be out in mid September. At that time we will email all of our club members the volunteer sign up forms. Competition will held during day and evening hours so there will be lots of opportunity (and need) for volunteering! Because this is a qualifying event there are specific protocols we must follow in various volunteer positions. We will have a training session for all volunteers as we get closer to the event. Youth volunteers must be age 12 or older and adult volunteers must be 16 or older.

All Northern Blades Club members, both registered and nonregistered, will receive an all event pass so they can come and watch some great skating and cheer on their fellow Northern Blades teammates that will be competing!



Talia is a Full Time NSC and NSC Northern Blades Coach for Freeskate and Choreography. She coaches all ages and levels. Talia is an ISI, USFS, and PSA Member. Talia started skating when she was 5 years old, and started coaching in 2014 after completing an internship at NSC and Graduating with a BS in Recreation and Sports Management. Her favorite skating memory is when she competed in her first USFS competition in Duluth. She skated a perfect program (landed all her doubles, had strong spins, and no missteps), which earned her First place. When standing on the podium to get her medal there were large cameras around and she found out it was going to be on the news that night advertising the competition. Later that night she watched the news and it showed all the girls getting medals on the podium after the event. It all was so exciting and she will never forget it.
